

## The History of Economic Thought as a Problem of Global History

Andrew Sartori is Professor of History at New York University. He obtained his PhD from the University of Chicago in 2003 and has since published several books. His latest, «Liberalism in Empire», was published with the University of California Press in 2014. He is co-editor of the «Cambridge Texts in the History of Political Thought» with Quentin Skinner.
